<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>All jurisdictions are asked to supply the single/couple codes in the reference period data extractions. Previously, a household's bedroom requirement has been calculated using the <a href="#">Proxy Occupancy Standard (POS)</a>, however under National Affordable Housing Agreement (NAHA) reporting requirements, the match of a dwelling to household size is based on <a href="#">Canadian National Occupancy Standard (CNOS)</a>.</p> <p>New low income cut-off measures for low income households based on new definition under NAHA.</p>
<b>Collection methods:</b>	<p>Data qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If records for persons in ended household cannot be supplied, special needs status for the ended household should be set in the household file to ensure all households are captured in the P5 special needs indicator.</li></ul>
<b>Comments:</b>	Refer to the collection period of the data set to determine the reference year for this cluster.
