CODE 4 Discharge/transfer to other health care accommodation (includes mothercraft hospitals)

In jurisdictions where mothercraft facilities are considered to be acute hospitals, patients separated to a mothercraft facility should have a mode of separation of Code 1. If the residential aged care service is the patient's place of usual residence than they should have a mode of constraint of Code 0.

then they should have a mode of separation of Code 9.

CODE 10 Discharge due to inactivity

This code is only used in ambulatory mental health settings.

CODE 11 Statistical discharge due to admitted care type change

This code is only to be used in admitted care settings when a care type has changed causing a statistical discharge but the patient has not physically left the hospital.
