<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>CODE 01 State or Territory Health Authority</p> <p>The highest level of health organisation in a state or territory, encompassing specialised and non-specialised health services.</p> <p>CODE 02 State or Territory Health Authority (specialised mental health)</p> <p>The highest level of specialised mental health organisation in a state or territory.</p> <p>CODE 03 Local Hospital Network</p> <p>The legal entity, <a href="#">Local Hospital Network</a> (LHN).</p> <p>CODE 04 Region</p> <p>The administrative entity specific to mental health care.</p> <p>CODE 05 Specialised mental health organisation</p> <p>This refers to specifically defined and separately constituted health services providing specialised mental health care designated as a specialised mental health organisation.</p> <p>CODE 06 Hospital</p> <p>This refers to a health care facility that may or may not provide specialised mental health care.</p> <p>CODE 07 Specialised mental health service unit</p> <p>The specified component of a health organisation that provides designated specialised mental health services, are those with a primary function to provide treatment, rehabilitation or community health support targeted towards people with a mental disorder or psychiatric disability. These activities are delivered from a service or facility that is readily identifiable as both specialised and serving a mental health care function.</p>

### Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	The ability of jurisdictions to generate unique identifiers varies. The assignment of <a href="#">Person identifier</a> to a uniquely identifiable individual is important for the ABF MHC DSS to permit the linkage of services between mental health care services.
<b>Collection methods:</b>	<p>For the purposes of activity based funding reporting, this data element can be derived from existing data elements.</p> <p>Ambulatory care- this data element can be derived from <a href="#">Person- Unique identifier used indicator, yes/no code N</a>.</p>
<b>Comments:</b>	For the purposes of reporting mental health care activity for activity based funding, the value reported should represent the highest level of organisation at which a unique patient identifier is applicable and allows all associated health care activity to be reported.
