## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	This data element should be used in conjunction with the data elements: <a href="#">Person—alcohol consumption frequency, AUDIT frequency alcohol consumption code N</a> and <a href="#">Person—alcohol consumption amount (self-reported), total standard drinks NN</a> to obtain a score on the Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT) and consequently obtain a risk of alcohol-related harm.
<b>Comments:</b>	The AUDIT is an alcohol screen that can help identify patients who are hazardous drinkers or have active alcohol use disorders (including alcohol abuse or dependence).
