

Definition: The collection of information about characteristics of interest from some, or all, units

of a population using well-defined concepts, methods and procedures.

Statistical surveys collect data to answer a question by placing a statistical value to an indicator or measure. Surveys measure one or more characteristics of the whole

population or a sample of the population.
