

Record if a female consumed alcohol monthly or less after 20 weeks of pregnancy

until the birth.

CODE 2 2-4 times a month

Record if a female consumed alcohol 2 to 4 times a month after 20 weeks of

pregnancy until the birth.

CODE 3 2-3 times a week

Record if a female consumed alcohol 2 to 3 times a week after 20 weeks of

pregnancy until the birth.

CODE 4 4 or more times a week

Record if a female consumed alcohol 4 or more times a week after 20 weeks of

pregnancy until the birth.

CODE 9 Not stated/inadequately described

This code is not for use in primary data collections.

Collection methods: This data element is self-reported.

Recommended question: 'How often did you have a drink containing alcohol after

the first 20 weeks of pregnancy?', where after 20 weeks of pregnancy is defined as

more than or equal to 20 weeks + 0 days.

To ensure consistency of results, this data element should be collected after the

birth.
