Record if a female smoked tobacco after 20 weeks of pregnancy until the birth.

CODE 2 No
Record if a female did not smoke tobacco after 20 weeks of pregnancy until the birth.

This data element should be recorded in conjunction with the [Female—number of tobacco cigarettes smoked per day after 20 weeks of pregnancy, number N\[NN\]](#) data element when the tobacco smoking after 20 weeks indicator is Code 1 (Yes).

Collection methods: This data element is self-reported.

Recommended question: 'Did you smoke at all after 20 weeks of pregnancy?', where after 20 weeks of pregnancy is defined as greater than or equal to 20 weeks + 0 days.

To ensure consistency of results, this data element should be collected after the birth.
