<b>Guide for use:</b>	CODE 1 Exit planned  Record for sentenced prisoners whose release was planned.  CODE 2 Exit not planned  Record for sentenced prisoners whose release was not planned. For example, a prisoner whose charges are dropped and the normal release process was not followed.
<b>Comments:</b>	Sentenced prisoners are those persons who have received a term of imprisonment from a court. This includes offenders who have been given an indeterminate sentence or custodial order, for example, persons detained under the 'Governor's/His/Her Majesty's Pleasure' and forensic patients, or those who have received a life sentence.
