**Description:** A DWAU is a unit of activity. Each dental service item from the Australian Dental Association schedule of services is attributed a relative value based on the price paid by the Commonwealth for dental services provided under the Department of Veterans Affairs Schedule of Dental Services. The indicator is calculated by multiplying all services provided by their respective DWAU values and summing the totals.
