Agencies should report the setting in which most of the main type of treatment was received by the client during the treatment episode.</p> <p><b>CODE 1   Non-residential treatment facility</b></p> <p>This code refers to any non-residential centre that provides alcohol and other drug treatment services, including hospital outpatient services and community health centres.</p> <p><b>CODE 2   Residential treatment facility</b></p> <p>This code refers to community-based settings in which clients reside either temporarily or long-term in a facility that is not their home or usual place of residence to receive alcohol and other drug treatment. This does not include ambulatory situations, but does include therapeutic community settings.</p> <p><b>CODE 3   Home</b></p> <p>This code refers to the client's own home or usual place of residence.</p> <p><b>CODE 4   Outreach setting</b></p> <p>This code refers to an outreach environment, excluding a client's home or usual place of residence, where treatment is provided. An outreach environment may be any public or private location that is not covered by Codes 1-3. Mobile/outreach alcohol and other drug treatment service providers would usually provide treatment within this setting (e.g. at a mutually agreed public space).</p> |
