Context:	An antenatal care visit may occur in the following clinical settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• antenatal outpatient clinic• specialist outpatient clinic• general practitioner surgery• obstetrician private room• community health centre• rural and remote health clinic• independent midwife practice setting including home of pregnant female.
