Collection and usage attributes

Computation description:	Both the numerator and the denominator include patients with a final diagnosis of acute stroke. The final diagnosis is made at the hospital where the patient is admitted for the acute phase of management of their stroke. Hospital 'presentation' means the time of the patients initial physical contact with the hospital in relation to their acute stroke. This may be through presentation to the emergency department, or direct admission to a ward. Presented as a percentage.
Computation:	$(\text{Numerator} \div \text{denominator}) \times 100$
Numerator:	Number of patients with a final diagnosis of acute stroke seen by a physiotherapist within 48 hours of presentation to hospital.
Denominator:	Number of patients with a final diagnosis of acute stroke who separated from hospital.
