Collection and usage attributes

Computation description: Both the numerator and the denominator include patients with diagnosed MI.
The denominator excludes patients who died in hospital.
Presented as a percentage.

Computation: $(\text{Numerator} \div \text{denominator}) \times 100$

Numerator: Number of patients with a final diagnosis of MI who had their LVEF measured prior to separation from hospital.

Denominator: Number of patients with a final diagnosis of MI separated from hospital.
