Record if the female was between 0 and 13 completed weeks of pregnancy.

CODE 2 2nd trimester
Record if the female was between 14 and 28 completed weeks of pregnancy.

CODE 3 3rd trimester
Record if the female was 29 completed weeks of pregnancy or onwards.

CODE 9 Not stated/inadequately described
Record if the pregnancy trimester was not stated or inadequately described.
