## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Population group age from:</b>	50 years or older
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**Computation description:** For the patient to be counted in the numerator, the sessile serrated adenoma(s) and/or sessile serrated polyp(s) must be histologically confirmed. Diagnosis should be informed by *The World Health Organization Classification of Tumours. Digestive System 5<sup>th</sup> edition*.

Both the numerator and denominator only include patients with an intact colon. Both the numerator and denominator exclude patients with a finding of acute [inflammatory bowel disease](#).

Presented as a percentage.

**Computation:**  $(\text{Numerator} \div \text{Denominator}) \times 100$

**Numerator:** The number of patients undergoing a colonoscopy with at least one sessile serrated adenoma or sessile serrated polyp detected.

**Denominator:** The number of patients undergoing a colonoscopy.
