## Identifying and definitional attributes

<b>Metadata item type:</b>	Data Element Concept

<b>Definition:</b>	The number of episodes of completed residential care occurring during the reference period. This includes both formal and statistical episodes of residential care.

## Object Class attributes

<b>Definition:</b>	The period of care between the start of residential care (either through the formal start of the residential stay or the start of a new reference period) and the end of the residential care (either through the formal end of residential care or the end of the reference period, i.e. 30 June).

### Collection and usage attributes

<b>Comments:</b>	For <a href="#">residents</a> provided with care intended to be on an overnight basis. This may occasionally include episodes of residential care that unexpectedly ended on the same day as they started (for example, the resident died or left against advice) or began at the end of the reference period (i.e. starting care on 30 June).
