<b>Classification structure:</b>	<p>Tier 2 classes provide a consistent framework for counting non-admitted service events. They are based on an assessment of both the type and specialty of the health-care professional providing the service and the nature of the service provided. This has resulted in a number of classes that is sufficient to ensure clinical meaningfulness and exclusivity across the spectrum of non-admitted services.</p> <p>The classes are also grouped into a number of categories that reflects the type of service provided and the health-care professionals that typically provide the service. The classes are grouped into four categories, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• procedures</li><li>• medical consultation</li><li>• stand-alone diagnostic</li><li>• allied health/clinical nurse specialist intervention.</li></ul>
