Elective surgery refers to procedures listed in Category 3 – Therapeutic Procedures Group: T8 – Surgical Operations of the Medicare Benefits Schedule that are performed by surgical clinicians and can be managed through a waiting list process.

CODE 2 Other

Other refers to procedures listed in Category 3 – Therapeutic Procedures Group: T8 – Surgical Operations of the Medicare Benefits Schedule:

1. that are performed by either surgical or non-surgical clinicians, but more frequently performed by non-surgical clinicians; or
2. or where the waiting period for patients awaiting transplant or obstetric procedures is largely independent of system resource factors.

Code 2 (Other) includes the following:

- biopsy (closed) (needle) of:
 - kidney
 - lung and pleura
 - liver and gall bladder or bile duct
- cosmetic surgery not attracting a Medicare rebate
- dental procedures not attracting a Medicare rebate
- endoscopy of:
 - biliary tract and pancreas
 - gastrointestinal (including panendoscopy (except when involving the bladder)
 - orthopaedic
 - respiratory/ear, nose and throat (including bronchoscopy, pharyngoscopy, laryngoscopy, tracheoscopy, nasendoscopy and otoscopy)
 - urological/gynaecological
- endovascular interventional procedures
- in vitro fertilisation
- miscellaneous cardiac procedures
- miscellaneous lower urinary tract procedures
- obstetrics and procedures associated with obstetrics (e.g. elective caesarean section, cervical suture)
- organ or tissue procurement and transplant
- peritoneal dialysis, renal dialysis and other interventions for renal dialysis
- other diagnostic and non-surgical procedures (e.g. chemotherapy).

These procedure terms are also defined by the Australian Classification of Health Interventions (ACHI) codes which are listed in the Comments field below. This coded list is the recommended, but optional, method for determining whether a patient is classified as requiring elective surgery or other care.

Comments:

The table of ACHI procedure codes was originally prepared by the National Centre for Classification in Health. A review of this data element was conducted in 2021 and procedure codes were added to some sections to make them more complete (e.g. organ transplant). Other procedures and categories were added as they are listed in the Tier 2 non-admitted services definitions manual sourced from the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority within the 10 series - Procedure Classes category. These procedures can be claimed by hospitals on an outpatient/non-admitted basis. In jurisdictions which have a dedicated outpatient/non-admitted clinic to perform the procedures, a formal admission process is not required for procedures such as angioplasty, panendoscopy, colonoscopy.

Revision status:	ACHI was developed by the National Centre for Classification in Health (NCCH) at the University of Sydney. During the development, the NCCH was advised by members of the NCCH Coding Standards Advisory Committee (CSAC) and the Clinical Classification and Coding Groups (CCCG), consisting of expert clinical coders and clinicians nominated by the Clinical Casemix Committee of Australia. In 2010, the National Casemix and Classification Centre (NCCC) at the University of Wollongong assumed responsibility for ACHI development and maintenance. NCCC developed the 2012 version of ACHI, released for implementation in 2013. In 2013, the NCCH at the University of Sydney once again assumed responsibility for ACHI development and maintenance, as part of a consortium under the name of the Australian Centre for Classification Development (ACCD). The ACCD comprises the NCCH, the University of Western Sydney and KPMG. From 1 July 2014, all ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS and AR-DRG related products are available for purchase from the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority (IHPA).
