Rationale:	The primary care needs of all Australians are met effectively through timely and quality care in the community. Good antenatal care is associated with positive health outcomes for mothers and babies.

Collection and usage attributes

Computation description: Proportion of female [Indigenous regular clients](#) who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who:

- had gestational age of less than 11 weeks recorded at their first [antenatal care visit](#);
- had gestational age of 11–13 weeks recorded at their first antenatal care visit;
- had gestational age of 14–19 weeks recorded at their first antenatal care visit;
- had gestational age of 20 weeks or later recorded at their first antenatal care visit;
- did not have gestational age recorded at their first antenatal care visit; or
- did not attend an antenatal care visit.

Presented as a percentage.

Calculated separately for each gestational age range.

Birth: includes live births and still births if the birthweight was at least 400 grams or the gestational age was 20 weeks or more.

Previous 12 months: refers to either the previous financial year or the previous calendar year.

Computation: $(\text{Numerator} \div \text{Denominator}) \times 100$

Numerator: Calculation A: Number of female Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who had a gestational age of less than 11 weeks recorded at their first antenatal care visits.

Calculation B: Number of female Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who had a gestational age of 11–13 weeks recorded at their first antenatal care visit.

Calculation C: Number of female Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who had a gestational age of 14–19 weeks recorded at their first antenatal care visit.

Calculation D: Number of female Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who had a gestational age of 20 weeks or later recorded at their first antenatal care visit.

Calculation E: Number of female Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who did not have a gestational age recorded at their first antenatal care visit.

Calculation F: Number of Indigenous regular clients who gave birth within the previous 12 months, and who did not have an antenatal care visit recorded.
