## Collection and usage attributes

An applicant can be a married couple, a de facto couple or a single person. The method by which the applicant becomes an official client will vary for each jurisdiction, and may be when the department first opens a file, when the applicant registers, or when they are invited to attend an information session.

Applicants who are already a client of the department but are applying to adopt a subsequent child, or reapplying to adopt, should be counted as applicants applying for the first time.
