## **Registration statuses**

## What is a registration status?

A registration status is the value assigned to a metadata element as it progresses through the registration process (or metadata life cycle). Registration statuses signify levels of quality and completeness of the element from the point of view of the registration authority. The status of metadata elements as they progress through the registration process also affects their visibility to different users (for example, metadata developers and the general public). Registration statuses in METEOR are based on <a href="ISO/IEC 11179">ISO/IEC 11179</a>.

The following table provides more detail on the meaning and visibility of Registration Statuses. The 11179 definitions are also provided.
