	An IHI is automatically assigned to all individuals registered with Medicare Australia or enrolled in the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) programs. Those not enrolled in Medicare Australia or with the DVA are assigned a temporary number when they next seek health care; this is then validated by the HI Service Operator and becomes their unique IHI.	
	Each IHI has a Record Status; this describes whether verification of the identifier of the individual has occurred and is based on the evidence available of a person's identity.	
Collection methods:	The IHI number does not change regardless of the person's Record Status.	
	Each IHI also has a Number Status; this describes whether the IHI number is in use.	
	Authorised healthcare providers and their authorised staff can access an individual's Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) online through the HI Service at the <u>Australian Government Services Australia</u> website.
