## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Guide for use:</b>	The end date is collected by the <a href="#">aged care service</a> . It refers to the last day services were delivered to the person. For care delivered on a one-off or session basis, the end date may be the same as the start date.
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It does not apply to periods of leave from care. For people who take leave from care who do not return, the episode end date is their last day of care, not the leave end date.
