## Collection and usage attributes

**Guide for use:**

CODE 1 Self-injured person

CODE 2 Health professional

Health professional includes nurse, doctor and allied health professionals.

CODE 3 Sports first aid/sports trainer

Includes the sports first aid personnel or sports trainer.

CODE 4 Parent or guardian

Includes the parent or legal guardian of the person with the injury.

CODE 5 Family

Includes family members of the injured person other than the parent or legal guardian.

CODE 6 Friend

Includes an unrelated person who is known to the injured person.

CODE 7 Team manager

Includes the sporting team manager of the injured person.

CODE 8 Sporting official

Includes sporting officials, e.g., umpires.

## Relational attributes

In the ASIDD this data element collects information on the person providing the injury details on the data collection form. It does not collect the setting where data was collected. Typically, but not always, this will be the person providing the initial management, treatment or assessment of the injury, e.g., emergency department staff, sports trainer etc.

The item is useful for identifying who is completing the forms in a particular setting and also establishing expectations on the quality of the data
