Operationalisation of smoking status: where an Indigenous regular client's tobacco smoking status does not have an assessment date assigned within the Clinical Information System (CIS), smoking status as recorded in the CIS should be treated as current (that is, as having been updated within the previous 24 months).

Calculation A: Number of Indigenous regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'current smoker' within the previous 24 months.

Calculation B: Number of Indigenous regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'ex-smoker' within the previous 24 months.

Calculation C: Number of Indigenous regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'never smoked' within the previous 24 months.
