## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Computation description:</b>	<p>To be included in the numerator, a patient with a hip fracture must have received protein and energy oral nutritional supplements (ONS) during their hospital admission. There must be documented evidence of the provision of ONS in the patient's medical record, foodservices system or the menu ordering system record.</p> <p>ONS are defined as protein and energy nutrient-dense products purposed to increase dietary intake when diet alone is likely to be inadequate to meet nutritional requirements. These may include energy and protein enriched drinks (eg. milk, soy, protein-fortified juice flavours), powders, soups, and/or desserts.</p> <p>Presented as a percentage.</p>
<b>Computation:</b>	$(\text{Numerator} \div \text{Denominator}) \times 100$
<b>Numerator:</b>	Number of admitted patients with a hip fracture who received protein and energy oral nutritional supplements during their hospital admission.
<b>Denominator:</b>	Number of admitted patients with a hip fracture.
