

burden of disease for First Nations people. It is important that First Nations primary health-care organisations know the smoking status of clients in order to provide

appropriate medical care.

Computation description: Count of First Nations regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status

result recorded within the previous 24 months was:

current smoker;

ex-smoker; or

never smoked.

Presented as a number.

Calculated separately for each smoking status.

Operationalisation of smoking status: where a First Nations regular client's tobacco smoking status does not have an assessment date assigned within the Clinical Information System (CIS), smoking status as recorded in the CIS should be treated as surrent (that is, as boying been undeted within the previous 24 months).

as current (that is, as having been updated within the previous 24 months).

Include: results arising from measurements conducted outside of the organisation

that are known by the organisation.

Computation: Numerator only.

Numerator:

Calculation A: Number of First Nations regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'current smoker' within the previous 24 months.

Calculation B: Number of First Nations regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'ex-smoker' within the previous 24 months.

Calculation C: Number of First Nations regular clients aged 11 and over whose smoking status result was recorded as 'never smoked' within the previous 24 months.
