CODE 3 Tier 3 registration category

A lower level of performance requirements and engagement reflecting that these providers are involved in activities that necessitate management of a lower level of risk.

CODE 4 Housing provider

The category assigned by the Victorian Housing Registrar as defined by the *Housing Act 1983* (Vic).

CODE 5 Housing association

The category assigned by the Victorian Housing Registrar as defined by the *Housing Act 1983* (Vic).

CODE 8 Other
